Connect

Predict

Using your own experiences, plus any clues from the pictures and text you have read, can you predict what may come next?

Question

Can you ask yourself questions, reread some parts and even research to develop a greater understanding of the text?

Visualise

Create a picture in your mind based on what you are reading, such as a character or a scene from the text.

Summarise

Can you retell the story in your own words, remembering to include all the key events?

Monitor

When you read something in the text that is confusing or doesn't seem to make sense, can you STOP and check for understanding?
