*(Required for applicants with a cumulative GPA of 2.0-2.9 or are core deficient).*

How have your past experiences influenced your academic record? What are you presently doing to ensure your academic success? What are your academic goals and how will our university help you accomplish these goals? You are encouraged to include your involvement and leadership contributions, in your home, school, or community.

### EASTERN WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY - EWU

Insight Resume (Written Experiential Assessment):

1. Describe examples of your leadership experience in which you have significantly influenced others, helped resolve disputes or contributed to group efforts over time. Consider responsibilities to initiatives taken in or out of school.
2. Describe any of your special interests and how you have developed knowledge in these areas. Give examples of your creativity; the ability to see alternatives; take diverse perspectives; come up with many, varied or original ideas; or willingness to try new things.
3. Describe the most significant challenge you have faced and the steps you have taken to address this challenge. Include whether you turned to anyone in facing that challenge, the role that person played, and what you learned about yourself.
4. Explain what you have done to make your community a better place to live. Give examples of specific projects in which you have been involved over time.
5. Describe your experiences facing or witnessing discrimination. Tell us how you responded and what you learned from those experiences and how they have prepared you to contribute to the EWU community.

- A. Discuss how your family's experience or cultural history enriched you or presented you with opportunities or challenges in pursuing your educational goals.
- B. Tell us a story from your life, describing an experience that either demonstrates your character or helped to shape it.

(Choose one of the following two topics and write a short essay. Maximum length: 300 words)

1. The University of Washington seeks to create a community of students richly diverse in cultural backgrounds, experiences and viewpoints. How would you contribute to this community?
2. Describe an experience of cultural difference or insensitivity you have had or observed. What did you learn from it?

**TIP:** You may define culture broadly in Topic #2. For example, it may include ethnicity, customs, values, and ideas, all of which contribute to experiences that students can share with others in college. As you reply to this question, reflect on what you have learned — about yourself and society — from an experience of cultural difference.
