Its importance for livelihoods cannot be overstated. 94 percent of rural residents and 38 percent of urban residents engage in agriculture to some extent. Smallholder crops are primarily maize which accounted for nearly 80 percent of smallholder cultivated land in 2011 followed by cassava and other food crops. As such the Malawian food supply especially in rural areas where markets are thin with few buying or selling options is shaped largely by trends in smallholder food crop production.
