The Victorians and English Dialect Matthew Townend, 2024-06-24 *The Victorians and English Dialect* tells the story of the Victorians' discovery of English dialect and of the revaluation of local language that was brought about by the new historical philology of the nineteenth century. Regional dialects came to be seen not as corrupt or pernicious but rather as venerable and precious. The book examines the work of the ground-breaking collectors of the 1840s and 1850s who first alerted their contemporaries to the importance of local dialect and also to the perils that threatened it with extinction. It traces the connection between dialect and literature in the flourishing of dialect poetry and the foregrounding of regional voices in Victorian fiction. It explains how the antiquity of regional dialects cast light on the national past: the Celts, Anglo-Saxons and Vikings, and how dialect study was also at the heart of the discovery of local folklore and oral culture: old words, old customs, old beliefs. And it tells the story of the three great monuments of Victorian dialect study that marked the apogee of regional philology: the 80 publications of the English Dialect Society (1873-96), an organization run by a committee of journalists and local historians in Manchester; the nationwide survey of *The Existing Phonology of English Dialects* (1889) which listened in on local speech in market squares and third-class railway carriages; and the multi-volume *English Dialect Dictionary* (1898-1905) which collected all the previous labours together and made an enduring record of Victorian dialect. *The Spectator*, 1896

An ample store of letters and anecdotes suggests Beckett's own preoccupation with and resistance to similar interpretive mindsets. Yet until now such concerns have remained the stuff of scholarly footnotes and asides. *Beckett's Imagined Interpreters and the Failures of Modernism* addresses these issues head

on and investigates how Beckett's ideas about who he writes for affect what he writes. What it finds speaks to current understandings not only of Beckett's techniques and ambitions but also of modernism's experiments as fundamentally compromised challenges to enshrined ways of understanding and organizing the social world. Beckett's uniquely anxious audience targeting brings out similarly self-doubting strategies in the work of other experimental twentieth-century writers and artists in whom he is interested; his corpus proves emblematic of a modernism that understands its inability to achieve transformative social effects all at once but that nevertheless judiciously complicates too neat distinctions drawn within ongoing culture wars. For its re-evaluations of four key points of orientation for understanding Beckett's artistic ambitions, his arch critical pronouncements, his postwar conceptions of value and valuelessness, his often ambiguous self-commentary, and his sardonic metatheatrical play as well as for its running dialogue with wider debates around modernism as a social phenomenon, this book is of interest to students and researchers interested in Beckett, modernism, and the relations between modern and contemporary artistic and social developments.

Claude Lévi-Strauss Patrick Wilcken, 2010-10-07 When Claude Lévi-Strauss passed away in 2009 at age 100, France celebrated the life and contributions of not only a preeminent anthropologist but one of the defining intellectuals of the 20th century. It was in France that structuralism, the school of thought he founded, first took hold, creating waves far beyond the field of anthropology. In his heyday, Lévi-Strauss was both a hero to contemporary intellectuals and an international celebrity. In *Claude Lévi-Strauss*, Wilcken gives the reader a fascinating intellectual tour of the anthropologist's landmark works: *Tristes Tropiques*, his most famous book, a literary meditation on his travels and fieldwork; *The Savage Mind*, which showed that primitive people are driven by the same intellectual curiosities as their Western counterparts; and finally his monumental four-volume *Mythologiques*, a study of the universal structures of native mythology in the Americas. In the years that Lévi-Strauss published these pioneering works, Wilcken observes, tribal societies seemed to hold the answers to the most profound questions about the human mind. Following the great anthropologist from São Paulo to the Brazilian interior and from New York to Paris, Patrick Wilcken's *Claude Lévi-Strauss* is both an evocative journey and an intellectual biography of one of the 20th century's most influential minds.
