expected with unemployment rising The OBR endorse all but one of the costings for the tax and spending measures set out in Budget 2011 HC 836 ISBN 9780102971033 as reasonable central estimates though there are significant uncertainties around a number of them The central forecast for economic growth in 2011 is revised down from 2.1 to 1.7 per cent On the fiscal outlook OBR forecast that public sector net borrowing will decline steadily as share of national income but more slowly than forecast in November The Government set itself two medium term fiscal targets to balance the cyclically adjusted current budget by the end of a rolling five year period and to see public sector debt falling in 2015/16 Examining performance against these targets the OBR believe there is a greater than 50 per cent probability of meeting both targets under current policy
