Essays from the Edge Martin Jay,2011-06-10 Over his distinguished career as a European intellectual historian and cultural critic Martin Jay has explored a variety of major themes the Frankfurt School the exile of German intellectuals in America during the Nazi era Western Marxism the denigration of vision in twentieth century French thought the discourse of experience in modern Europe and America and lying in politics Essays from the Edge assembles Jay s writings from the intersections of this intellectual journey Several essays focus on methodological debates in the humanities and social sciences the limits of interdisciplinarity the issue of national or universal philosophy cultural relativism and visuality and the implications of periodization in historical narrative Others examine the concept of scopic regime and the metaphors of revolution and the gardening impulse Among the theorists treated at length are Theodor Adorno Hannah Arendt Jacques Derrida and Michel Foucault The essays also include several of Jay s Salmagundi columns dealing with subjects as varied as the new Museum of Modern Art in New York the impact of Colin Wilson s *The Outsider* and the demise of the Partisan Review All of these efforts can be considered what Arthur Schopenhauer called to borrow the title of one of his most celebrated collections *parerga and paralipomena* As essays from the edges of major projects they illuminate Jay s major arguments elaborate points made only in passing in the larger texts and explore ideas farther than would have been possible given the focus of the larger works themselves The result is a lively diverse offering from an extraordinary intellect

Two Essays in Finance Ward R. Kangas, 1997-10 Based on data on publicly traded insurance firms the first essay examines questions about the effect of large catastrophic events on insurance firms Rather than looking at a single event thirty catastrophic events were aggregated into quintiles and the cumulative abnormal returns around these events were found to be significantly positive over a 25 day trading window There is no significant evidence that post catastrophic stock returns are correlated to the magnitude of the catastrophe The second essay analyzes the effect of a large land grant university the University of Illinois on the State Treasury of Illinois If the State Treasury were acting as its own agent trying to maximize revenues would it choose higher education as an investment versus other alternative investments While it is true the State makes large expenditures for the operations of the University it is also true that individuals receiving degrees on average receive higher incomes Taxes or higher incomes offset the cost of operating the University The study is broken out by the level of student undergraduate masters doctorate medical professional and by function of the University It was found that all levels of education have a positive return not only for the individual but also for the State Treasury This is in excess of any non pecuniary benefits to the State of having a better educated population or the local taxation effects on the county or city where the campus is located These returns are found to be higher than other types of investments

Production Xinghua Liu, Rui Alexandre Alves, Angelique Aitken, Josef Schmied, 2025-10-30 Academic writing in this Research Topic refers to the type of writing demonstrating students disciplinary knowledge of and proficiency in synthesizing analyzing and responding critically to new information Hyland 2004 Swales 1990 which may include those genres like course essays project reports research proposals lab notes journal articles conference paper theses and dissertations As the current workplaces have become increasingly specialized higher education worldwide has been increasingly charged with the task of developing students academic writing and correspondingly on students parts learning through writing has been necessary for them to succeed in higher education To prepare university students for writing challenges during the past decades numerous studies have been devoted to the study of linguistic and rhetorical resources in students academic writing under such umbrella terms like style reader awareness authorial voice writers identity stance evaluation textual structures steps and moves Charles Hunston Hinkel 2002 However previous research on academic writing has been predominantly focused on the linguistic and rhetorical aspects namely the final product of students writing while the nature and processes of composition students engagement and individual differences and the influence of contextual factors like emerging technology have been
