1. **Situation.** Per reference (a), the III Marine Expeditionary Force (MEF) and Marine Corps Installations Pacific-MCB Camp Butler (MCIPAC-MCBB) are charged with establishing the holiday liberty schedule each year.

2. **Mission.** This order establishes the special liberty hours to be observed by III MEF and MCIPAC-MCBB as per references (b) and (c).

3. **Execution**

a. **Commander's Intent.** III MEF and MCIPAC-MCBB will observe the following special liberty hours for the prescribed events:

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b. **Tasks.** Commanders will emphasize the importance of good judgment, adhering to Coronavirus Disease 2019 mitigation measures and the responsible use of alcohol during the holiday periods.

c. **Coordinating Instructions:**

(1) Operational requirements may surface which will supersede the authorized liberty.

(2) Civil service employees will observe the Federal holiday. Liberal leave is encouraged for civil service employees for the remainder of the special liberty period. Any leave taken will be charged as annual leave or leave without pay, as appropriate. Supervisors are authorized to release civil service employees 59 minutes early on the day before commencement of the holiday period and for any day that employees work during the liberty period where mission and work load allow.

(3) Super Bowl special liberty applies to III MEF and MCIPAC-MCBB Marines and Sailors stationed west of the International Date Line. Liberal leave is authorized for civil service employees.

(4) Spring break special liberty applies to all III MEF and MCIPAC-MCBB Marines and Sailors. Liberal leave is authorized for civil service employees.

4. **Administration and Logistics.** None.

5. **Command and Signal.** This Bulletin is applicable to all III MEF and MCIPAC-MCBB major subordinate command and major subordinate element personnel.
