century In the current debate expansionists want to see more legal immigrants in the U S and greater tolerance if not respect for immigrants Restrictionists favor lower levels of immigration stronger borders and tighter law enforcement measures to stop the stream of illegal migration and alleged crime The aim of this book is to describe how these opposing views materialized in the news media political rhetoric and ultimately in policy Much of our argument rests on the idea that history matters that the dominant narrative about immigration is in constant flux and that the winner of the immigration debate is determined by a vector of contextual elements the joint impact of current events enduring traditions and political economic forces Our approach to the immigration debate avoids deterministic claims and grand scale projections Although we argue with conviction that a climate of fear played an important role in shaping the debate the fear itself and its effects on social attitudes and public policy were neither inevitable nor necessarily long lasting Tropical Agriculture ,2015-10

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
