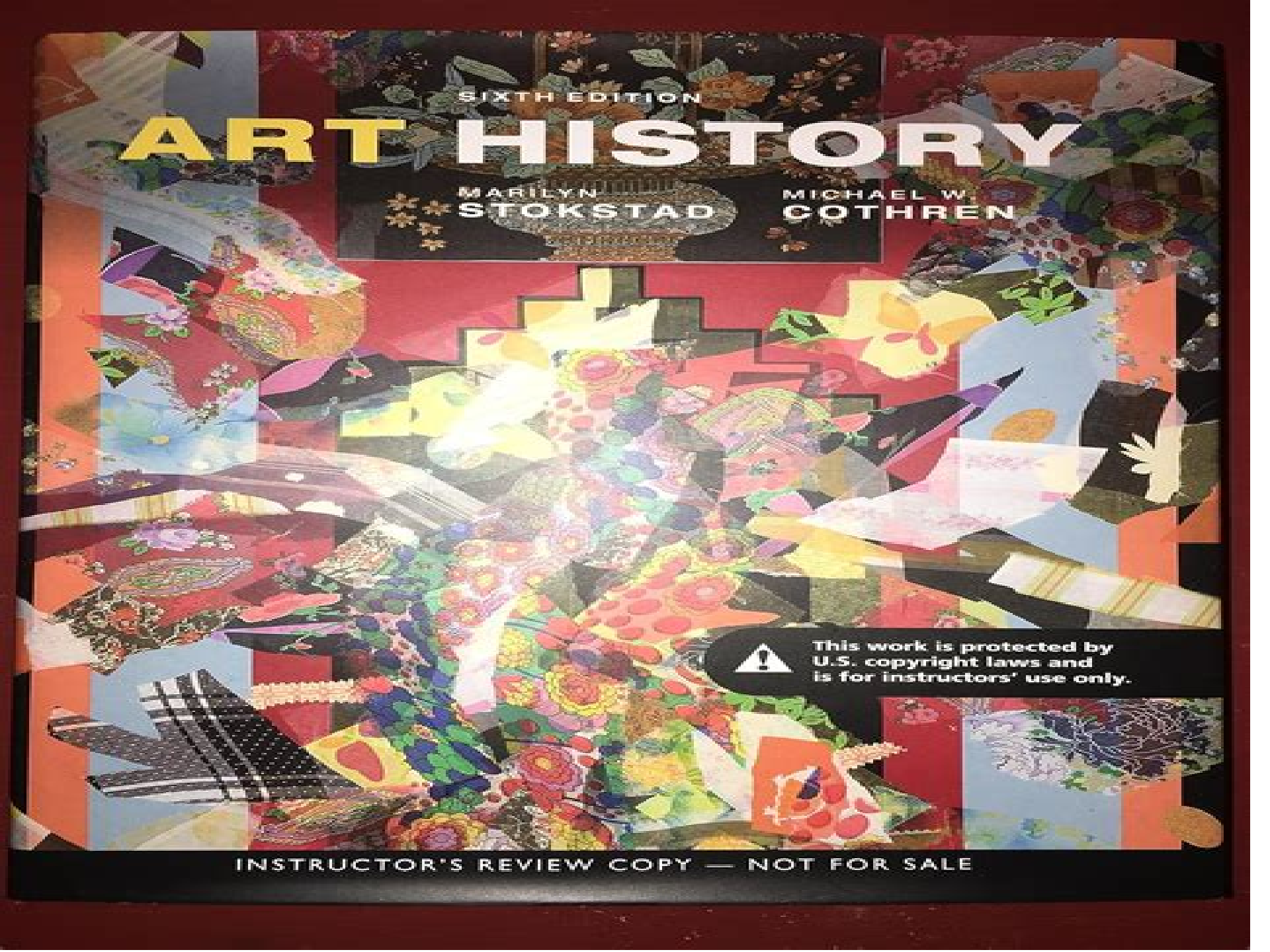

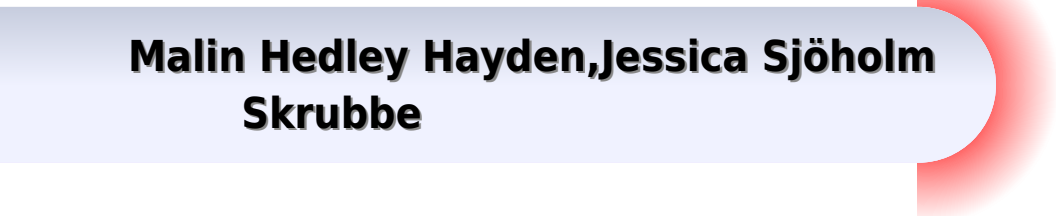

the truths the royal leaders of his world could not or refused to see today's artists are both revealing the darkness within the culture and offering a way out. *Waiting for Godot* has been proclaimed the greatest play of the twentieth century. But there are no great roles in it, no characters representing the equivalent of Shakespeare's Hamlet. Rather, the two main characters are closer to T. S. Eliot's J. Alfred Prufrock, who says he cannot be a Hamlet, only perhaps Hamlet's Fool. This book explores what has happened as Europe's culture fragmented and the world lost its center.
