Vani Sethi,Manisha Nair,Neena Bhatia ,Zivai Murira,Charu Arora,Divya Tripathi,2025-04-29 South Asia contributes to 40 per cent of the annual global low birth weight burden with an estimated 10 million children born with low birth weight Poor women s nutrition and gender inequalities are the main causes for stagnantly high prevalence of low birth in South Asia In South Asia most women enter pregnancy with one of more nutrition risks 22% of women are too thin 49% women are anaemic 20% suffer from obesity 10% are adolescents and 35% are too short for their age The low diversity of diets of women is worrisome particularly in fragile countries for example 26% of adolescent girls and women access a minimally diverse diets in Afghanistan Data also shows that 90% of women in India Bangladesh and Pakistan are affected with at least one of the three micronutrient deficiencies iron zinc and folate
