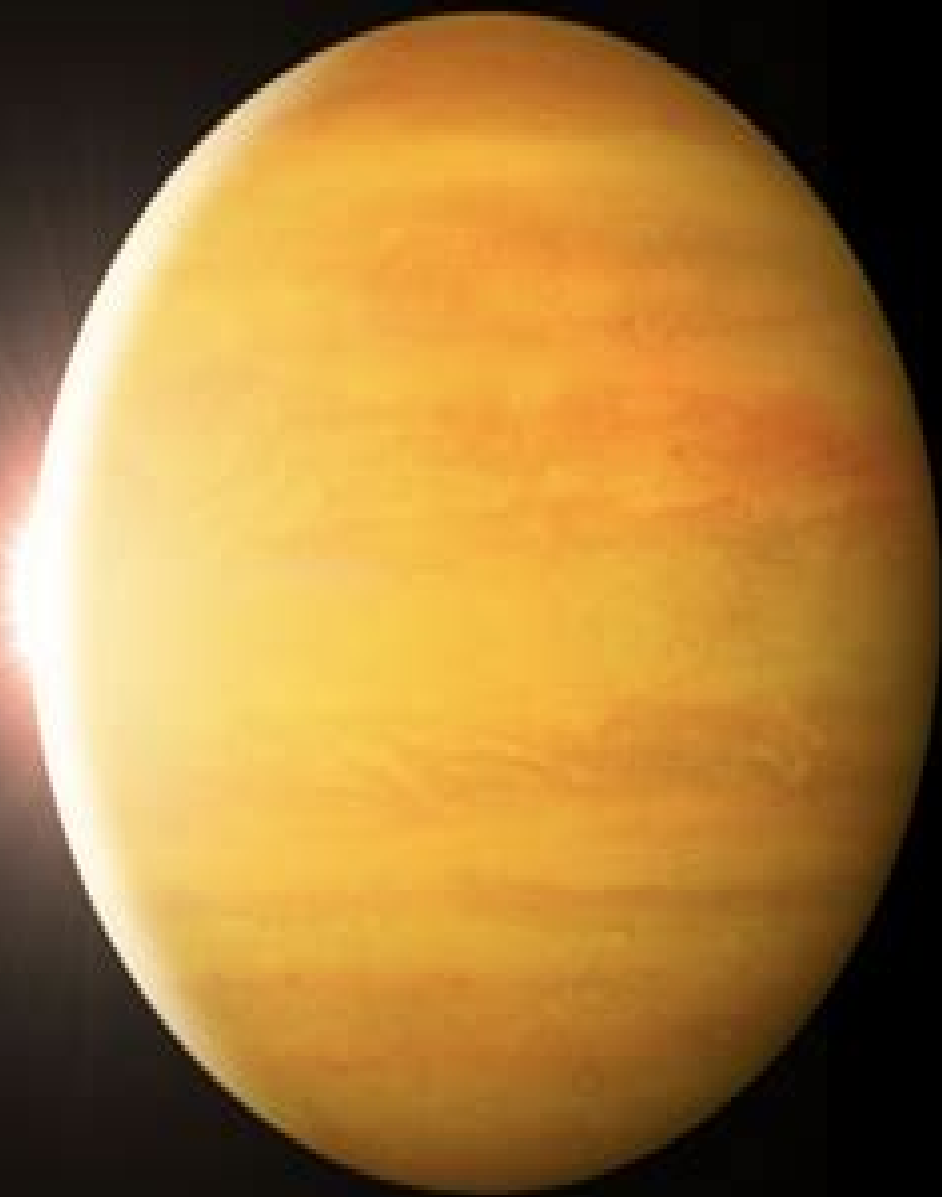

around stars similar to our own This discovery opened the floodgates for a new era in astronomy leading to a rapid increase in the number of known exoplanets Detecting these far off worlds however is no simple task Because exoplanets are small and dim compared to their host stars they are incredibly difficult to observe directly As a result astronomers have developed indirect methods for detection The radial velocity method measures the slight wobble of a star caused by the gravitational pull of an orbiting planet The transit method perhaps the most prolific in terms of discoveries involves observing the slight dip in a star's brightness when a planet crosses in front of it
