Cross, 2012-12-06 The subject of baptism continues to be of considerable interest though it frequently appears within broader studies of sacraments liturgy worship and ecumenical studies and within confessional bounds credobaptist or paedobaptist yet it is rarely discussed by Evangelicals This book however is neither an apologetic for credobaptism nor paedobaptism rather Cross believes that as practiced today both forms are a departure from New Testament baptism which he maintains was an integral part of becoming a Christian and part of the proclaimed gospel He argues that the one baptism of Ephesians 4 5 is conversion baptism and that the baptism referred to in the various New Testament strata refers to this one baptism of Spirit and water

The study sets out the case for this interpretation and contends that in key passages baptism is an example of synecdoche The case is then made for a sacramental interpretation of baptism from a thoroughgoing Evangelical perspective Cross concludes with reflections on the necessity of baptismal reform and the relevance of a return to conversion baptism for the contemporary church in a post Christian post Christendom mission setting Liturgical Music as Ritual Symbol Judith Marie Kubicki,1999 In this book Sister Kubicki uses Jacques Berthier's Taize music to explore the nature of liturgical music as ritual symbol She carries out a hermeneutical analysis of Berthier's chants and examines biographical and historical data related to the creator's of Taize music and the founding of the Taize community. Lynch, 2017 Recalling the Biblical and Patristic roots of the Church's sacramental identity the Second Vatican Council calls the Church the visible sacrament of that unity offered through Christ LG 9 Sacrament in this sense not only describes who the Church is but what she does In this regard the Council Fathers were careful to establish a strong connection between the symbolic nature of the Church's sacraments and their effect on those who received them Reginald Lynch is concerned with the cleansing of the heart a phrase borrowed from St Augustine and employed by Aquinas which describes the effects that natural elements such as water or bread have on the human person when taken up by the Church as sacramental signs Aguinas approach to sacramental efficacy is unique for its integration of diverse theological topics such as Christology merit grace creation and instrumentality While all of these topics will be considered to some extent the primary focus of The Cleansing of the Heart is the sacraments understood as instrumental causes of grace This volume provides the historical context for understanding the development of sacramental causality as a theological topic in the scholastic period emphasizing the unique features of Aguinas response to this question Following this relevant texts from Aquinas early and later work are examined noting Aquinas development and integration of the idea of sacramental causality in his later work The Cleansing of the Heart concludes by contrasting alternatives to Aguinas theory of sacramental causality that subsequently emerged The rise of humanism introduced many changes within
