Women's engagements encompass the full range of media from translation to cinematic adaptation and from early colonial performance to contemporary theatrical experiment. Simultaneously *Women and Indian Shakespeares* makes visible the ways in which women are figured in various representational registers as resistant agents, martial seductresses, redemptive daughters, victims of caste discrimination, conflicted spaces and global citizens.
