Schönthal, 2008-02-05** Intracellular checkpoint controls constitute a network of signal transd tion pathways that protect cells from external stresses and internal errors Ext nal stresses can be generated by the continuous assault of DNA damaging agents such as environmental mutagens ultraviolet UV light ionizing radiation or the reactive oxygen species that can arise during normal cellular metabolism. In response to any
