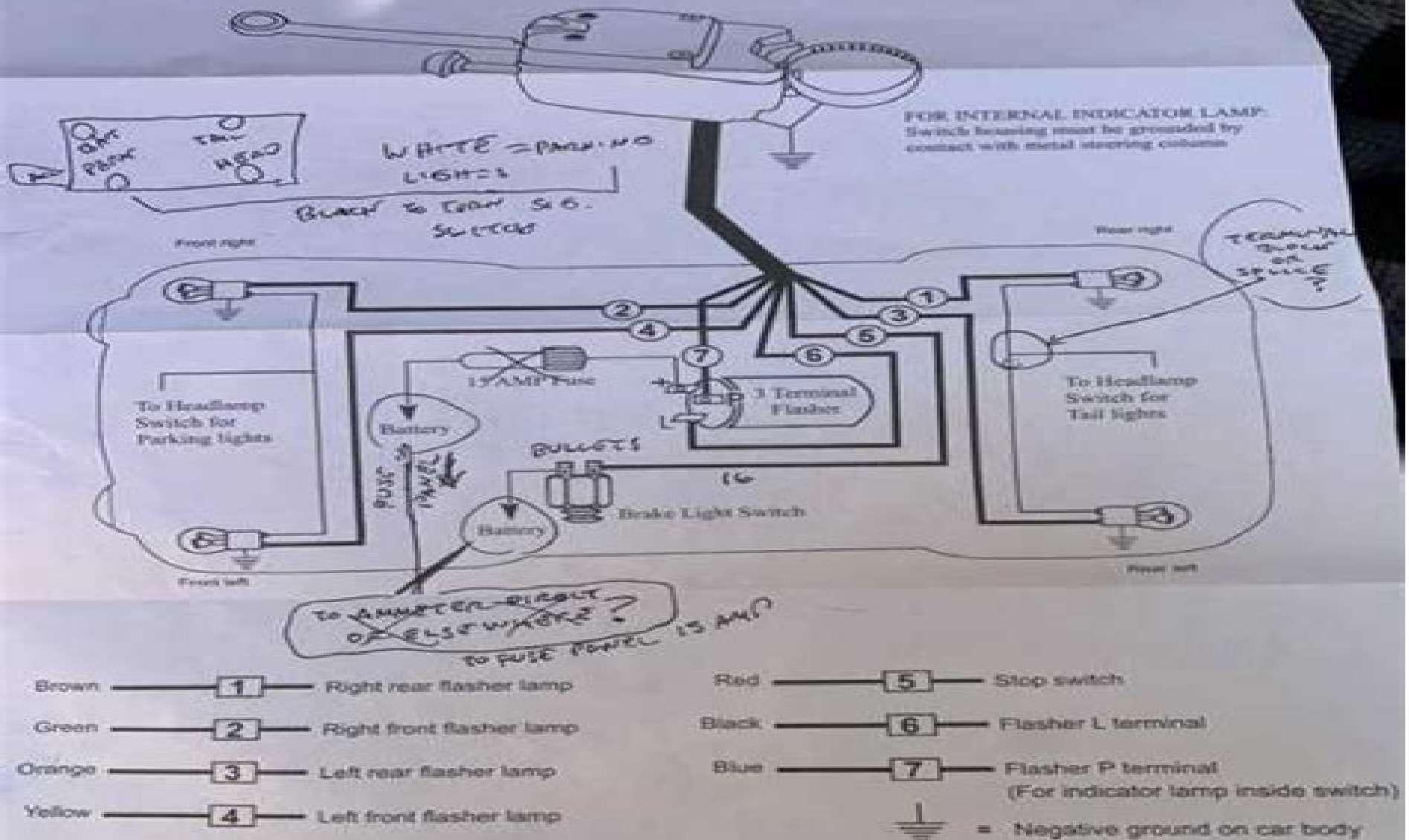




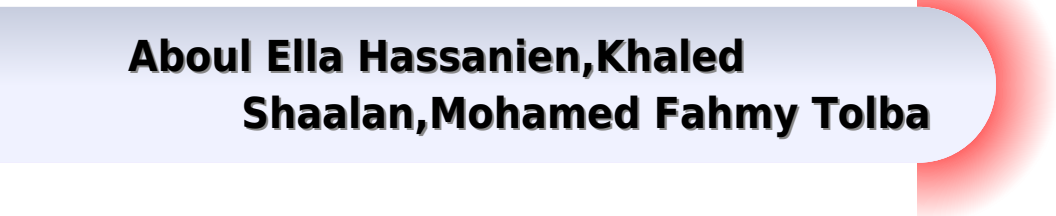

In 1989 the handbook was republished by Optical Technologies Inc. It contained the same glossary. In 1986 with the assistance of this author the National Communications System published FED STD 1037A Glossary of Telecommunications Terms with a few fiber optics terms. In 1988 the Electronics Industries Association issued EIA 440A Fiber Optic Terminology based primarily on PB82-166257. The International Electrotechnical Commission then published IEC 731 Optical Communications Terms and Definitions. In 1989 the second edition of this dictionary was published.
