The writer provides a suggestion about how to solve the problem. Americans are the largest consumers of oil. Instead of drilling for oil, we should decrease our need for foreign oil simply by using less. We must all work together to cut back on the oil we use in order to preserve the wildlife of the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge.

The writer ends his or her paper with an appeal to the reader to help solve the problem.
