The sounds commonly are these; however, they could also be infection, cardiac failure, and other pulmonary disorders.

### TESTING TIPS!

If you see the term 'Snoring' in your question, it must be fixed immediately!
The first step is to simply reposition the airway. If that is not an option, the next step is to determine if the patient is responsive to Verbal or Pain (this can even be a groan or arms twitch) or if they are completely unresponsive.

Completely unresponsive is corrected with an Orophargeneal Airway, and if they are responsive, even to pain, it's a nasopharyngeal airway adjunct.

If your patient presents with 'Wheezing,' this can go in two different directions! This is most likely Asthma or Bronchitis, and deciding which one is easy!

ASTHMA - They have a history of asthma, and because this is a reactive airway disease, it is a sudden onset. This patient is fighting hard to cough mucus and may have a low SPO2 from airway bronchial constriction.

BRONCHITIS- These patients have not been feeling well for over 24 hours.

They feel weak, and tired and may or may not have a productive cough.
