According to the Narrative of the Life of Frederick Douglass, there are cases when the narrator remembers a number of slaveholders who whipped the nude backs of slaves as well as watch as flesh was cut of their body and large pints of blood was lost.

Slaves to the white society were compared to domestic animals (Douglass 49). He as well remembers a case whereby his boss perished without dotting a will. This clarified that proprietorship of the bosses' assets was to be relocated to his two kids. In line with words of Douglass, men were compared to horses, whereas women were seen as cattle and children slaves to pigs (Douglass 39). The white community from this viewpoint failed to see slaves as human beings rather as animals whose duty was to serve in fulfilling the desires of
