The Four Roads to Heaven Edwin Mullins, 2018-04 THERE ARE FOUR ROADS LEADING TO SANTIAGO WHICH COMBINE TO FORM A SINGLE ROAD So begins *The Pilgrim's Guide* the world's first guidebook Written early in the twelfth century by Benedictine monks it served travelers taking part in the great pilgrimage of the Middle Ages to the tomb of the apostle St James the cousin of Christ at Santiago de Compostela in northwest Spain The four roads are all in France from Paris in the north from Vézelay in Burgundy from Le Puy en Velay in the Massif Central and from Arles in Provence all threading their way across the country before joining as a single road in northern Spain A step by step account of these four journeys through medieval France the Guide's aim was to explain to pilgrims the religious sites they would see on their way to Santiago but it also offered advice on where to stay what to eat and drink and how to avoid dishonest innkeepers and murderous boatmen Edwin Mullins follows the same four roads as they exist today in the footsteps of those medieval travelers He explores the magnificent churches abbeys and works of art which are the proud legacy of the pilgrimage as well as reconstructing a turbulent period of history that encompassed wars crusades and the reconquest of Spain Many of the buildings and landmarks that sprang up along the pilgrim routes still stand there today and *The Four Roads to Heaven* brings to life their historical architectural and spiritual significance From imposing Romanesque and Gothic cathedrals to humble pilgrims hospices this book looks at the living legacy of one of the great social phenomena of the Middle Ages the pilgrimage to Santiago Richly illustrated with Adam Woolfitt's color photographs *The Four Roads to Heaven* offers an invaluable guide nine hundred years after its predecessor to the paths still trodden by increasing numbers of pilgrims *The Four Roads to Heaven* Edwin Mullins, 2017 There are four roads leading to Santiago which combine to form a single road So begins *The Pilgrim's Guide* the world's first guidebook Written early in the twelfth century by Benedictine monks it served travellers taking part in the great pilgrimage of the Middle Ages to the tomb of the apostle St James the cousin of Christ at Santiago de

designated a World Heritage Site in 1993. Actually a network of paths with numerous starting places in France and throughout Europe all routes converge to lead along Spain's northern coast to Santiago de Compostela. Here the shrine of St James the patron saint of pilgrimage was discovered in the 9th century. The content includes well-trodden domains of pilgrimage scholarship like sacred sites and holy places. Spanish Dramatists of the Golden Age Mary Parker, 1998-09-17. The Golden Age of Spanish drama extends from the close of the 15th century to the death of Calderón in 1681. During that time the humanists, as dramatists, followed Italy's artistic awakening, direction and imitated Classical drama. With originality and dreams of greatness, they subverted the nature of tragedy, modified the approach of Comedy and invented the New Play, the Comedia Nueva. In it, the poet-dramatists introduced important modifications of realism, included imagined reality, Christian symbolism and

theatricality as artistic truth They elaborate all kinds of syntheses For this reason the Spanish Golden Age theater can be viewed as part of a tradition that includes the Greco Roman comedy and tragedy Christian tragedy and the authentic national literary and dramatic tendencies The entries in this reference book explore the fascinating history of the Golden Age of Spanish drama The volume begins with an introductory overview of the literary cultural and historical contexts that shaped dramatic writing of the period The book then presents alphabetically arranged essays for nineteen significant Spanish dramatists of the Golden Age Each essay is written by an expert contributor and includes biographical information an analysis and evaluation of major works a discussion of critical response to the plays and an extensive bibliography of primary and secondary sources The volume closes with a selected general bibliography of central critical studies of Golden Age Spanish drama
