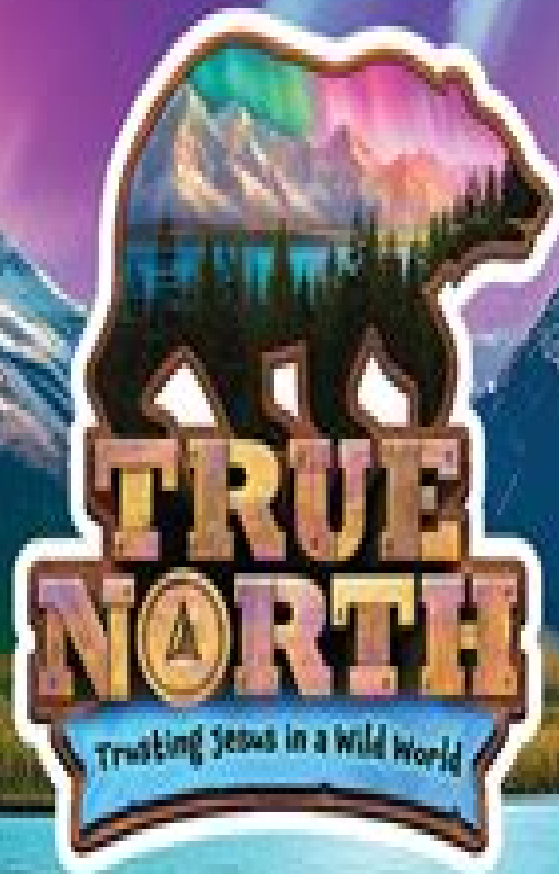

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To The North:

Advisory Commission on Intergovernmental Relations,1974 *Invitation to The North* Hermann Tietgen,2023-09-27 A man with a recent degree in Agriculture from the University of Berlin Hermann came to Canada in 1930 to escape inflation and lack of jobs in Germany A chance encounter led him to the North and a job prospecting for gold He fell in love with the North like so many others had done before him In 1939 the declaration of war against Germany stopped all searches for gold in the North Suddenly other minerals were more important This brought all the gold prospectors to Edmonton from the North and there were many more men than jobs Hermann his wife and little daughter moved back to Montreal where he was hoping to find a job Fortunately through a friend of a friend he did land a job at an alloy producing plant in Beauharnois Quebec near Montreal The first job was as a stoker on a platform above the huge vats of molten metal stirring the mass which would be used to make armoured

steel for vehicles and tanks for the Canadian Armed Forces He worked at St Lawrence Alloys as a Stores Keeper and then as the Purchasing Agent until he retired in 1968 He died in 1970 never having returned to the North which he loved so well This is his story in his own words A Gazetteer of the Countries Adjacent to India on the North-West Edward Thornton,1844

The Race to the North David Wragg,2013-01-21 In the late nineteenth century some of Britains leading main line railway companies threw caution to the winds in an attempt to provide the fastest passenger express services between London and Scotland These became known as the races to the north There were two phases in 1888 and 1895 and they spurred the building of new bridges across the Firth of Forth and Firth of Tay David Wraggs gripping detailed narrative tells the story of this epic engineering and commercial competition He concentrates on the determination of the railway companies to see who could provide the fastest schedule between London and the main Scottish cities of Edinburgh Glasgow Perth Dundee and Aberdeen Casting aside their early policy of co existence on these prestigious and lucrative routes the West Coast and East Coast companies were drawn into a period of intense highly publicized rivalry as they sought to dominate the market David Wragg gives an insight into the conduct of the well publicized highs and tragic lows of this dramatic story the extension of the lines to the far north the building of the Tay and Forth bridges including the collapse of the first Tay bridge with 72 fatalities and the repeated bids by the companies to cut the journey times While he describes the public side of this fascinating story David Wragg fills in the background which is no less interesting the pioneering engineering of the steam age the massive construction projects the cut throat battle for passengers and freight and the deep inter company rivalries that drove the rapid development of the railways during the Victorian period *Glaciations in North and South America from the Miocene to the Last Glacial Maximum* Nat Rutter,Andrea Coronato,Karin Helmens,Jorge Rabassa,Marcelo Zárate,2012-06-30 Improved dating methods have increased our ability to more precisely determine the timing and durations of glaciations Utilizing glacial and loess deposits we have compared glaciations that occurred in North and South America in order to determine if events are synchronous or not to explore forcing mechanisms and to compare glaciations with cold periods of the Marine Oxygen Isotope stages and the loess paleosol records of China Stratigraphic sections containing a variety of glacial deposits some with interbedded volcanics as well as loess deposits were used in reconstructing the glacial history The Late Pleistocene Brunhes Chron Last Glacial Maximum is recognized in mountain and continental areas of North America but only in the mountains of South America Commonly our comparisons indicate roughly synchronous glaciations on the two continents whereas other glaciations are more elusive and difficult to compare Although our comparisons are at low resolutions the results suggest that Milankovitch forcing is most likely the dominant trigger for hemispheric glaciation modified by local factors The North American Lakes Considered as Chronometers of Post-glacial Time Edmund Andrews,1870 *Life of Sir John Franklin and the North-West Passage* Albert Hastings Markham,1891 **Snapshots from the North Pacific** William Ridley,1904

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
