The report was prepared as part of the Safe School Initiative The findings of the Initiative indicate that targeted school violence incidents are unlikely to be impulsive are likely to have observable pre planning activities and are likely to be known to other students prior to the event The goal of the document was to provide an outline of a process for identifying assessing and managing students who may be at risk for perpetrating targeted acts of school violence.
