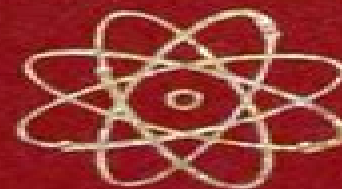

The most current and relevant tests are included; outdated tests have been eliminated. Test index with extensive cross references and disease index provide the reader with an easy way to find necessary information. Four new sections in key areas: Preanalytical, Flow Cytometry, Pharmacogenomics, and Allergy make this edition current and useful. New editor Alan Wu, who specializes in Clinical Chemistry and Toxicology, brings a wealth of experience and expertise to this edition. The Molecular Diagnostics section has been greatly expanded due to the increased prevalence of new molecular techniques being used in laboratories. References are now found after each test rather than at the end of each section for easier access.
