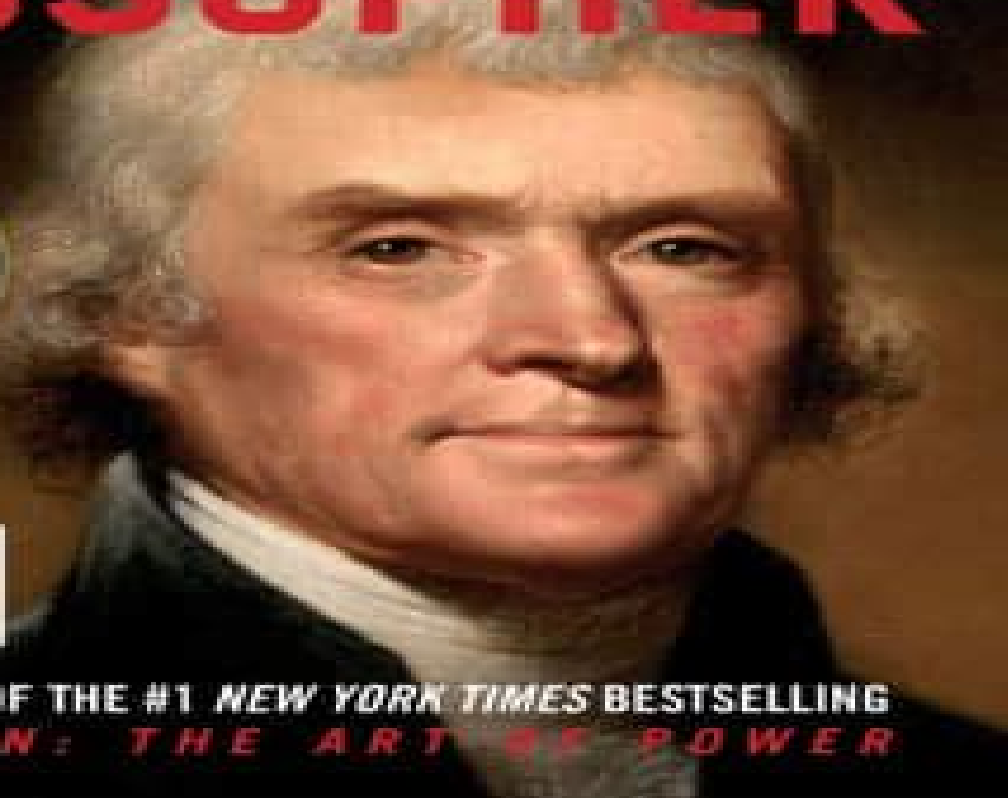


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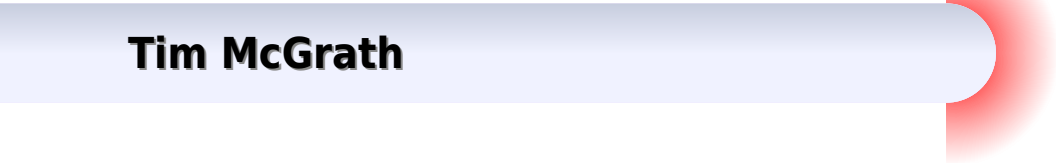

Andrew Holowchak, 2013-12-11 Though it is not uncommon for historians to have something to say concerning philosophical strands in Jefferson's thought that something is usually insubstantial often misleadingly so or inchoate Overall precious little has been said The significance of the man and the richness of his thought demands that this defect be remedied *Thomas Jefferson and Philosophy* is a collection of nine new essays on philosophical elements in Jefferson's writings The first of its kind this collection should lead to further philosophical analysis of Jefferson's thinking especially by philosophers who tend to appreciate Jefferson only as the author of the Declaration of Independence and to greater appreciation for the man who gave to statesmanship a large number of the prime of his years out of a moral sense of duty to others In that regard Jefferson was always first a philosopher This book will be a valuable read for students and scholars of history political theory and philosophy as well as anyone interested in the thought of Thomas Jefferson
