Finally, the presence of strong visual elements in the novel leads to an assessment of the critical reception accorded Franz Seitz's film adaptation of *Doctor Faustus* in 1982, a dicey subject in Mann circles since few filmed versions of his novellas or novels have enjoyed an unsullied reputation.
