The British and the Hellenes Robert Holland, Diana Markides, 2006-01-12 The Greek revolt against Turkish rule in the 1820s and the ensuing establishment of an independent Hellenic Kingdom was the principal precursor of an age of nationalism in the eastern Mediterranean world Amongst the Great Powers Great Britain thereafter played the most critical role in struggles to expand the frontiers of Greece beyond their initially confined extent Through a focus on events leading to the cession of the Ionian Islands to Greece in 1864 the often bloody process of Cretan unification climaxing in 1913 the adhesion of the Dodecanese to Greece in 1948 and the travails of British colonial rule in Cyprus through to independence in 1960 the book develops a comparative overview of the United Kingdom's engagements with the modern Hellenic experience At the heart of the various themes covered by this volume is the interaction between internal and external forces shaping the futures of divided island societies In exploring the resulting patterns the authors provide an original insight into the political and social morphology of the eastern Mediterranean Although the principal context is provided by Anglo Hellenic relations the nature of the struggles necessitate a close attention to Ottoman decline and post Ottoman succession Great Power rivalries ethnic and communal disintegration the early history of international peace keeping and decolonization after 1945 In tracing these preoccupations the often neglected significance of the eastern Mediterranean is more accurately situated in relation to British authority overseas and its limits Although the policy process is carefully charted the essential concern is with struggles of mastery within islands where Britons and Greeks amongst others found themselves frequently at odds In evoking the engagement between British power and Hellenic nationalism a fresh perspective is given to the modern history of the eastern Mediterranean and the Balkan and Near Eastern worlds to which they were intimately connected

Imperial Control in Cyprus Antigone Heraclidou, 2017-06-30 In Protectorate Cyprus education was one of the most effective tools of imperial control and political manipulation used by the British This book charts the cultural and educational aspects of British colonial rule in Cyprus and analyses what these policies reveal about the internal struggles on the island between 1931 and 1960 Cyprus had been under British occupation since 1878 but it was in the 1930s that educational policies acquired a strong political significance and became essential in preserving the British position on the island The co existence of two very strongly held and eventually conflicting national identities in Cyprus Greek Orthodox and Turkish Muslim inevitably led to the politicisation of education and culture on the island Therefore any attempts to impose British culture language and way of thinking onto Cypriots or even to create a distinct Cypriot identity had very limited success Gradually the education system reflected the shifting political developments in colonial Cyprus By the start of the 1950s schools had become a breeding ground for discontent and between 1955 and 1959 they were an indispensable part of the EOKA revolt In this book Antigone Heraclidou provides a new dimension to the understanding and origins of the deadlock that was to prove one of the most intractable in the final years of the British Empire

Cyprus Andrew Borowiec,2000-01-30 Borowiec portrays Cyprus as a permanent source of tension in the Eastern Mediterranean and a potential trigger for future conflict between Greece and Turkey He describes the depth of animosity

between Greek and Turkish Cypriots and analyzes the obstacles in the path of a search for a solution. Most casual observers see the conflict between Greeks and Turks on a strategic Mediterranean island as a struggle within a sovereign state. Borowiec concludes that there has never been a Cypriot nation only Greeks and Turks living in Cyprus separated by the hostility reflecting the traditional animosity between their motherlands. If these two groups could forget their past conflicts as did for example Germany and Poland there might be a way to end the partition of Cyprus. At the present time however the crisis is likely to continue with varying degrees of tension threatening the entire Eastern Mediterranean and undermining NATO's cohesion. Borowiec traces the history of Cyprus from antiquity through Ottoman and British colonial rule and the post independence period. He describes the break between the island's communities in 1963, the UN intervention of 1964 and the path toward the Athens junta's coup in 1974 which caused the Turkish invasion and occupation of the northern part of Cyprus. He compares the conflicting views of the protagonists, the Greek Cypriot majority and the Turkish Cypriot minority. Considerable attention is paid to the two separate economic and political entities on the island. Borowiec analyzes the futility of myriad international mediation efforts and suggests possible ways of creating a climate propitious to dialogue. This important new look at the Cypriot conflict will be valuable to researchers, policy makers and scholars involved with the Eastern Mediterranean and conflict peace studies.

Scott-Stevenson,1880 **Realism and Human Rights in US Policy toward Greece, Turkey, and Cyprus** Sotiris Rizas,2018-10-15 The theme of this book is the interplay between Realism and Human Rights in the formulation of US policy towards Greece and Turkey with respect to the Cyprus and the Aegean disputes and the domestic politics of the two countries from the Truman to the Carter administration The policies of successive administrations and those of Johnson and Nixon in the 1960s and 1970s were formulated upon the requirements of containment as this was conceived in 1946 47 by the Truman administration Realpolitik dominated the agenda and issues related to values and norms were secondary although not unimportant Whenever a choice had to be made between realpolitik and human rights the former was the main consideration of American policy makers Although committed to the recalibration of US foreign policy toward human rights the Carter administration did not depart from these premises in the formulation of its policy in the Eastern Mediterranean
