neurosurgeons emergency medicine physicians internists and radiologists In some areas family medicine general practice physicians may provide the majority of acute stroke care We will provide the reader with all the data necessary to understand the utility and limitations of thrombolytic therapy By reading the protocols and working through the case tutorials the reader will become sufficiently familiar with the indications and contraindications of thrombolytic therapy to begin evaluating potential patients Although nothing can replace direct instruction by more experienced physicians we hope that by imparting our accumulated knowledge we may guide those physicians who cannot attend a hands on workshop or who having heard the appropriate lectures feel the need for further guidance We will review the scientific rationale for thrombolysis first most ischemic stroke is caused by thrombo emboli second a portion of brain the penumbra remains salvageable for a few hours after vascular occlusion and third promptly delivered thrombolysis can remove the offending occlusion and restore cerebral blood flow to the penumbra in time to salvage brain and neurologic function Then we will review the preclinical development of thrombolytics for stroke patients and the early pilot trials Next we will present the pivotal clinical trials that demonstrated the efficacy and safety of thrombolysis
