desire devotion abjection and sexual obsession in the form of a novel like no other novel Robert Gluck's masterpiece bears comparison with the finest work of such writers as Kathy Acker and Chris Kraus This edition includes an essay by Gluck about the creation of the book titled *My Margery Margery's Bob* *Other Worlds* Teffi, 2021-04-20 Stories about the occult folk religions superstition and spiritual customs in Russia by one of the most essential twentieth century writers of short fiction and essays Though best known for her comic and satirical sketches of pre Revolutionary Russia Teffi was a writer of great range and human sympathy The stories on otherworldly themes in this collection are some of her finest and most profound displaying the acute psychological sensitivity beneath her characteristic wit and surface brilliance *Other Worlds* presents stories from across the whole of Teffi's long career from her early days as a literary celebrity in Moscow to her post Revolutionary years as an migrant in Paris In the early story *A Quiet Backwater* a laundress gives a long disquisition on the name days of the flora and fauna and on the Feast of the Holy Ghost a day on which no one dares disturb the earth The story *Wild Evening* is about the fear of the unknown *The Kind That Walk* a penetrating study of antisemitism and of xenophobia and *Baba Yaga* about the archetypal Russian witch and her longing for wildness and freedom Teffi traces the persistent influence of the ancient Slavic gods in superstitions and customs and the deep connection of the supernatural to everyday life in the provinces In *Volya* the autobiographical final story the power and pain of Baba Yaga is Teffi's own

The Fire Within Pierre Drieu La Rochelle, 2023-12-05 Adapted to film by both Louis Malle and Joachim Trier this heart rending and tenderly wrought novel narrates the decline of an artist and heroin addict in 1920s Paris Pierre Drieu la Rochelle might be said to be both the Hemingway and the Fitzgerald of twentieth century French literature a battle scarred veteran of the First World War whose work chronicles the trials and tribulations of a lost generation a man about town a heartbreaker with a broken heart a literary stylist whose work is as tough as it is lyrical and polished Politically compromised as Drieu came to be by his affiliation with the fascist right and collaboration under Nazi occupation Drieu committed suicide at the end of the war his novels remain vivid reflections of a broken spiritual and political world of the interwar years and as works of art and to this day they are widely read and greatly admired in France *The Fire Within* which has been successfully adapted to the screen by Louis Malle and more recently Joachim Trier is the lacerating tale of Alain Leroy a war veteran and beautiful young man of whom the world is expected but who has taken refuge from the world in drugs After being institutionalized Alain emerges to try to put his life together again but in spite of the attentions of friends and lovers he struggles to find his way *Nada* Jean-Patrick Manchette, 2019-08-27 This tour de force political thriller told in Manchette's signature noir style follows a group of far left extremists in the throes of post 1968 disillusionment The thrill of 1968 is long over and the heavy fog of the 1970s has settled in In Paris however the Nada gang or groupuscule still retains a militant attachment to its revolutionary dreams Bringing together an anarchist orphaned by the Spanish Civil War a Communist veteran of the French resistance a frustrated high school teacher of philosophy a timid office worker a terminal alcoholic and
