Fourteen year old Gyuri's father has been called up for labour service. Arriving at the family timber store he witnesses with nonchalance and boredom his father sign over the business to the firm's book keeper. Two months later he finds himself assigned to a permanent workplace but within a fortnight he is unexpectedly pulled off a bus on his way to work and detained without explanation. This is the start of his journey to and subsequent imprisonment in Auschwitz. On his arrival Gyuri finds that he is unable to identify with other Jews and in turn is rejected by them. An outsider among his own people his estrangement makes him a preternaturally acute observer. Kertész, 2005-10-25 Imre Kert sz s savagely lyrical and suspenseful new novel traces the continuing echoes of the Holocaust and communism in the consciousness of contemporary Eastern Europe. Ten years after the fall of communism a writer named B commits suicide devastating his circle and deeply puzzling his friend Kingsbitter. For among B's effects Kingsbitter finds a play that eerily predicts events after his death. Why did B who was born at Auschwitz and miraculously survived take his life? As Kingsbitter searches for the answer and for the novel he is convinced lies hidden among his friend's papers Liquidation becomes an inquest into the deeply compromised inner life of a generation. The result is moving, revelatory and haunting.

**The Conflagration of Community** J. Hillis Miller, 2011-08-01 After Auschwitz to write even a single poem is barbaric. The Conflagration of Community challenges Theodor Adorno's famous statement about aesthetic production after the Holocaust, arguing for the possibility of literature to bear witness to extreme collective and personal experiences. J. Hillis Miller masterfully considers how novels about the Holocaust relate to fictions written before and after it and uses theories of community from Jean-Luc Nancy and Derrida to explore the dissolution of community bonds in its wake. Miller juxtaposes readings of books about the Holocaust: Keneally's Schindler's List, McEwan's Black Dogs, Spiegelman's Maus and Kert sz s Fatelessness with Kafka's novels and Morrison's Beloved, asking what it means to think of texts as acts of testimony.

**The Exile and Return of Writers from East-Central Europe** John Neubauer, Borbála Zsuzsanna Török, 2009-10-28

This is the first comparative study of literature written by writers who fled from East Central Europe during the twentieth century. It includes not only interpretations of individual lives and literary works but also studies of the most important literary journals, publishers, radio programs and other aspects of exile literary cultures. The theoretical part of introduction distinguishes between exiles, migrants and expatriates while the historical part surveys the pre twentieth century exile traditions and provides an overview of the exilic events between 1919 and 1995. One section is devoted to exile cultures in Paris, London and New York as well as in Moscow, Madrid, Toronto, Buenos Aires and other cities. The studies focus on the factional divisions within each national exile culture and on the relationship between the various exiled national cultures among each other. They also investigate the relation of each exile national culture to the culture of its host country. Individual essays are devoted to Witold Gombrowicz, Paul Goma, Milan Kundera, Monica Lovinescu, Milo Crnjanski, Herta and Paul Paul and to the internal exile of Imre Kertész. Special attention is devoted to the new forms of exile that emerged during the ex-Yugoslav wars and to the problems of homecoming of exiled texts and writers.

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
