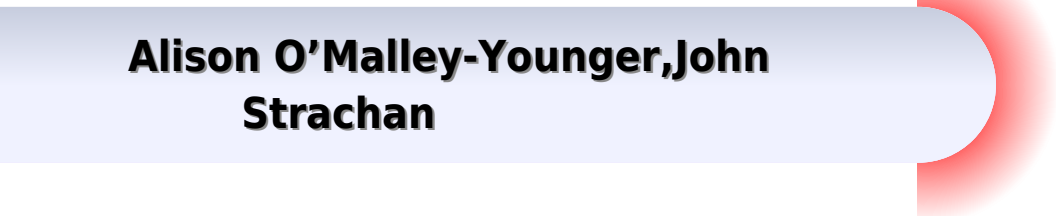

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War for Peace Murad Idris, 2019 Peace is a universal ideal but its political life is a great paradox peace is the opposite of war but it also enables war If peace is the elimination of war then what does it mean to wage war for the sake of peace What does peace mean when some say that they are committed to it but that their enemies do not value it Why is it that associating peace with other ideals like justice friendship security and law does little to distance peace from war Although political theory has dealt extensively with most major concepts that today define the political it has paid relatively scant critical attention to peace the very concept that is often said to be the major aim and ideal of humanity In *War for Peace* Murad Idris looks at the ways that peace has been treated across the writings of ten thinkers from ancient and modern political thought from Plato to Immanuel Kant and Sayyid Qutb to produce an original and striking account of what peace means and how it works Idris argues that peace is parasitical in that the addition of other ideals into peace such as law security and friendship reduces it to consensus and actually facilitates war it is provincial in that its universalized content reflects particularistic desires and fears constructions of difference and hierarchies within humanity and it is polemical in that its idealization is not only the product of antagonisms but also enables hostility *War for Peace* uncovers the basis of peace's moralities and the political functions of its idealizations historically and into the present This bold and ambitious book confronts readers with the impurity of peace as an ideal and the pressing need to think beyond universal peace

Boyne, 2024-09-04 A vivid chronicle of the military and diplomatic crisis that exploded between Israel and a coalition of Arab states in October 1973 The Yom Kippur War brought Arab and Jew into vicious conflict A war in which Israel almost unleashed her nuclear arsenal and set two superpowers on a treacherous course of nuclear escalation And a war that eventually brought peace But a peace fraught with delicate tensions disputed borders and a legacy of further bloodshed This is a war that Israel never thought was possible Surprised by the fury and excellent execution of the Arab onslaught and perhaps more than a little complacent Israel suddenly found itself on the point of losing a war because of a lack of ammunition planes and tanks The United States after much vacillation finally elected to help Israel beginning a tremendous airlift code name Operation Nickel Grass which incurred the wrath of the Arab states and their sponsor the Soviet Union Fortunately the airlift came just in time for Israeli ground forces to stabilize their positions and eventually turn the tide in the Sinai and Golan Heights And it was all made possible by an operation that dwarfed the Berlin Airlift and the Soviets simultaneous efforts in Egypt and Syria

War and Peace in the Western Political Imagination Roger Manning, 2016-03-10 The study of war in all periods of prehistory and recorded history has always commanded the attention of historians dramatists poets and artists The study of peace has however not yet gained a comparable readership and the subject is attracting an increasing amount of scholarly research This volume presents the first work of academic research to tackle this imbalance head on It looks at war and peace through the ages from the Classical world through to the 18th century It

considers the nature and advocacy of war and peace both from an historical perspective but also a philosophical one particularly looking at how universal peace which began as a personal philosophy became over the centuries a political philosophy that underpins much of modern society's attitudes towards warfare and militarism Roger Manning begins his journey through history by looking at the Greek martial ethos and philosophical concepts of peace and war in the ancient world moving through the Roman empire's military advances he explores the concepts of war and peace in the medieval world and the Renaissance with the writing of Machiavelli and Erasmus finally his account of the search for a science of peace in the 17th and 18th centuries brings the book to its conclusion

Chambers, 2015-05-29 In Families in War and Peace Sarah C Chambers places gender analysis and family politics at the center of Chile's struggle for independence and its subsequent state building Linking the experiences of both prominent and more humble families to Chile's political and legal history Chambers argues that matters such as marriage custody bloodlines and inheritance were crucial to Chile's transition from colony to nation She shows how men and women extended their familial roles to mobilize kin networks for political ends both during and after the Chilean revolution From the conflict's end in 1823 until the 1850s the state adopted the rhetoric of paternal responsibility along with patriarchal authority which became central to the state building process Chilean authorities Chambers argues garnered legitimacy by enacting or enforcing paternalist laws on property restitution military pensions and family maintenance allowances all of which provided for diverse groups of Chileans By acting as the fathers of the nation they aimed to reconcile the greater Chilean family and form a stable government and society
