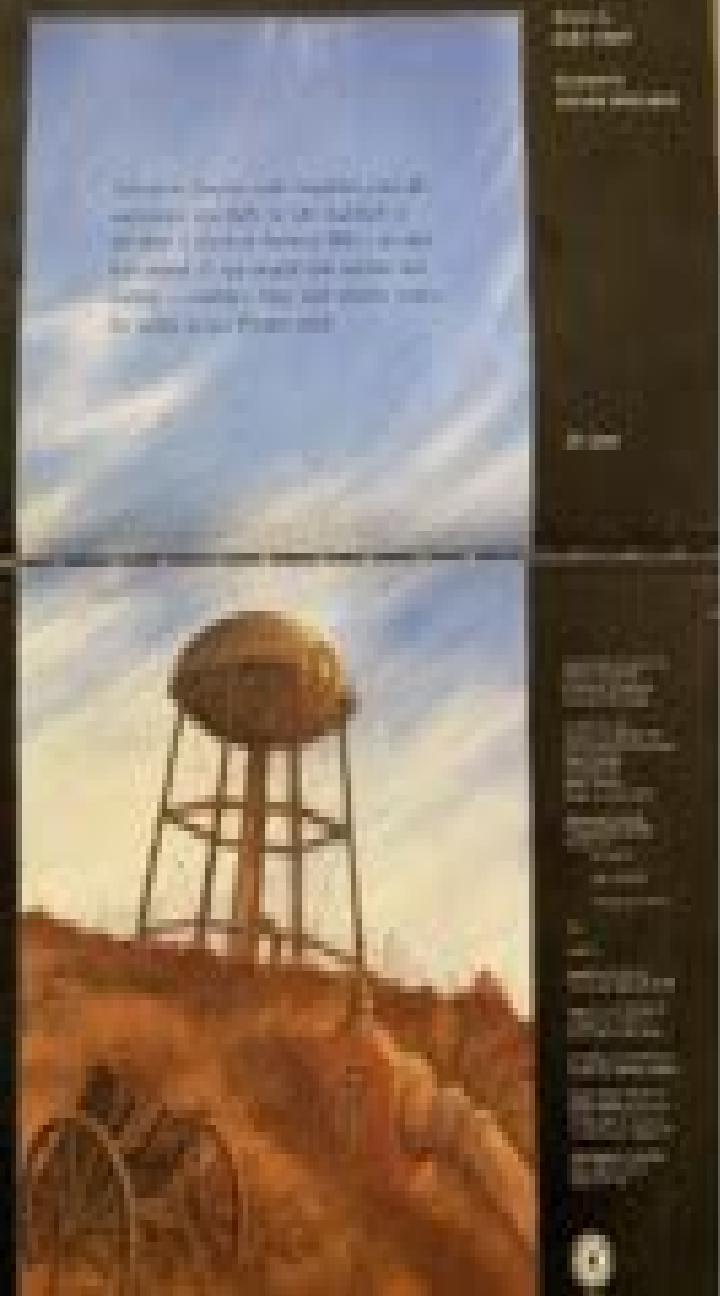


WATERTOWER
