VERB BASICS Want to improve your English? Start by learning more about VERBS!

- 1) What is a verb? A word that expresses:
A) Action
B) Condition
C) State of being
2) Verbs are commonly known as **ACTION** words

FINITE VERBS ("MAIN VERBS")

- 1) Make a statement
EG: The accident ruined my car.
2) Express a state of being
EG: I feel good today.
3) Can remain by themselves in a sentence
EG: Stop!

NONFINITE VERBS ("VERBALS")

- 1) Are **NOT** complete and so cannot be used by themselves in a sentence
2) Instead, they need to be used with auxiliary ("helping") verbs
3) Nonfinite verb forms include:
A) Gerunds (verb form that functions as a noun)

- B) Infinitives (to + verb form; multiple functions)
C) Participles (verb form that functions as an adjective)
EG: *Dancing is great exercise.* (gerund)
They plan to go dancing this weekend. (infinitive)
Do you like my new dancing shoes? (participle)

THE FIVE PROPERTIES OF VERBS: PERSON, NUMBER, TENSE, VOICE & MOOD

PERSON

- 1) **PERSON** indicates who is:
A) Speaking (first person)
B) Being spoken to (second person)
C) Being spoken about (third person)

NUMBER

- 2) **NUMBER** demonstrates whether one item or idea (singular) or more than one item or idea (plural) is intended:
A) Singular
EG: She reads a book.
B) Plural
EG: They read books.

Person and Number	
Sentence	Person/Number
I read.	first person singular
You read.	second person singular/ plural
He/she reads.	third person singular
We read.	first person plural
They read.	third person plural

Third person plural (they) is also used when it is someone's known preference or gender is unknown.

TENSE

- 3) **TENSE** explains the time of the action or the state of being, which can occur in the present, the past, or the future

- A) There are six verb tenses, each conveying a different span of time

NOTE: Examples apply to regular verbs only

- i) **Present tense** expresses an action or state of being that is occurring in the present time or that happens regularly
EG: This cookie *tastes* delicious.
ii) **Past tense** expresses an action or state of being that began and ended in the past (sometimes called the **preterite tense**)
EG: The runner *finished* the race.

- iii) **Future tense** expresses an action or state of being that will occur in the future. Use *shall* or *will* before the present form of the verb.
EG: She *will* be sad when she hears the truth.

- iv) **Present perfect tense** expresses an action or state of being that:

- i) Began in the past and continues into the present

OR

- ii) Was completed at an unspecified time in the past

- i) Use *have* or *has* before the past participle form of the verb.
EG: John F. Kennedy's assassination *has puzzled* people for decades.

- ii) **Past perfect tense** demonstrates an action or state of being in the past that occurred before another action in the past

- i) Use *had* before the past participle form of the verb
EG: Before she left, she *had asked* him to take care of her dog.

- iii) **Future perfect tense** demonstrates an action or state of being in the future that will be finished before another action or state of being in the future

- i) Use *will have* or *shall have* before the past participle form of the verb
EG: The kids *will have completed* summer camp before the school year begins.

- B) **PROGRESSIVE** forms show ongoing action and correspond to each of the six tenses

- i) Use the necessary form of *be* before the present participle form of the verb

EG: He *is raking* the leaves. (present progressive)

He *was raking* the leaves. (past progressive)

He *will be raking* the leaves. (future progressive)

He *has been raking* the leaves. (present perfect progressive)

He *had been raking* the leaves. (past perfect progressive)

He *will have been raking* the leaves. (future perfect progressive)

Tense	Sentence
Present tense	She <i>plays</i> with dolls.
Present progressive tense	She <i>is playing</i> with dolls.
Past tense	She <i>played</i> with dolls.
Past progressive	She <i>was playing</i> with dolls.
Perfect tense	She <i>has played</i> with dolls.
Past perfect tense	She <i>had played</i> with dolls.
Future tense	She <i>will play</i> with dolls.
Future perfect tense	She <i>will have played</i> with dolls.

VOICE

- 4) **VOICE** explains whether the subject of a sentence performs or receives the action expressed by the verb

- A) **Active voice** occurs when the subject performs the action
B) **Passive voice** occurs when the subject of the sentence receives the action

- i) Active voice requires an auxiliary (helping) verb plus the main verb

EG: The boy *caught* the ball. (active voice)

The ball *was caught* by the boy. (passive voice)

MOOD

- 5) **MOOD** shows the manner in which the verb expresses an idea. There are three moods:

- A) **Indicative mood** is used to state a fact or ask a question and is the most commonly used mood in the English language

EG: She *loves* him most in this world.

- B) **Imperative mood** is used to state a command or make a request

EG: Be there by noon.

- C) **Subjunctive mood** is used to express doubt, wishing, hope, belief, or improbability

EG: If I *were* taller, could I play basketball?

NOTE: Some verbs take different forms in the subjunctive while others appear in the same form as in the indicative.

Did You Know?

Overuse of passive voice can make writing awkward and less forceful. The students *were given* an assignment by the teacher. (passive)

OR

The teacher *gave* the students an assignment. (active)

When in doubt, be "pro-active" – active voice is usually clearer, crispier, and more succinct.

CONJUGATION

CONJUGATING verbs is a vital component to learning any new language; *to conjugate* means to create various forms of the verb from one basic form.

Did You Know?

Every language in the world *conjugates* its verbs (in some way) – to everyone, everywhere, needs to learn how to conjugate

REGULAR VERBS

- 1) If it is a **REGULAR** verb, the past tense and the past participle are formed by adding the ending "-ed" or "-en" to the present tense form
2) Regular verbs are consistent; the past tense of the verb always ends in "-ed," as does the past participle

Regular Verbs (First-Person Singular)

Present	Present Participle	Past	Past Participle
bounce	am bouncing	bounced	(have) bounced
clean	am cleaning	cleaned	(have) cleaned
jump	am jumping	jumped	(have) jumped
laugh	am laughing	laughed	(have) laughed
start	am starting	started	(have) started
wash	am washing	washed	(have) washed

IRREGULAR VERBS

- 1) Unlike regular verbs, the past and past participle forms of **IRREGULAR** verbs are **NOT** created by adding "-ed" or "-en" to the present tense form; instead, they are formed in irregular ways

- 2) Irregular verbs are **NOT** consistent

Which is Which?

Lay and *lie* are not the same word, but they are often confused because the past form of *lie* is *lay*.

Lie down!

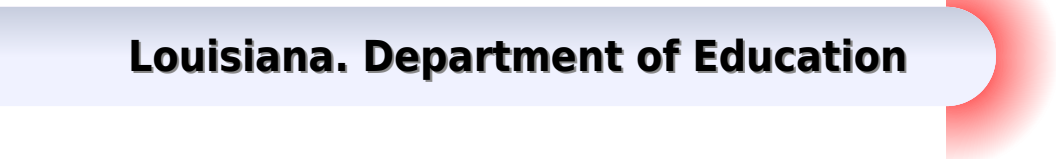
Lay!
