

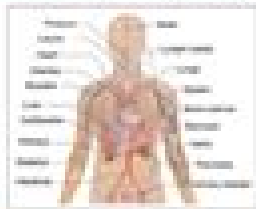

Anatomy

The scientific study of the structure of the human body

Physiology

The scientific study of the function of the human body

Structural levels

Also known as the levels of organization of the human body

- 1. Chemical level - study of the chemical composition of the body
- 2. Cellular level - study of the structure and function of cells
- 3. Tissue level - study of the structure and function of tissues
- 4. Organ level - study of the structure and function of organs
- 5. System level - study of the structure and function of systems
- 6. Organism level - study of the structure and function of the whole organism

CELLS AND TISSUES

Cells are the basic units of structure and function of the human body



Composition of cellular fluids

Cells are composed of various fluids

Extracellular fluid - fluid outside the cell

Intracellular fluid - fluid inside the cell

Interstitial fluid - fluid between cells

Blood plasma - fluid part of blood

Organic fluids - fluids containing organic molecules

Inorganic fluids - fluids containing inorganic molecules

Electrolytes - substances that conduct electricity

Non-electrolytes - substances that do not conduct electricity

Acids - substances that release hydrogen ions

Bases - substances that accept hydrogen ions

pH - measure of acidity or alkalinity

Homeostasis - the body's ability to maintain a stable internal environment

Feedback loops - mechanisms that regulate homeostasis

Positive feedback - amplifies a response

Negative feedback - reduces a response

Set point - the desired value of a variable

Range - the acceptable range of values for a variable

Stimulus - a change in the environment that triggers a response

Receptor - a structure that detects a stimulus

Effector - a structure that responds to a stimulus

Response - the body's reaction to a stimulus

Adaptation - a change in the body that improves its ability to survive

Evolution - the process of change in the characteristics of a population over time

Speciation - the process of new species formation

Extinction - the disappearance of a species

Biological diversity - the variety of life forms

Conservation - the protection of natural resources

Sustainability - the ability to meet the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs

Renewable resources - resources that can be replenished

Non-renewable resources - resources that cannot be replenished

Recycling - the process of converting waste into reusable materials

Carbon footprint - the amount of greenhouse gases emitted by an individual or organization

Climate change - the long-term change in the Earth's climate

Global warming - the increase in the Earth's average temperature

Greenhouse effect - the process by which greenhouse gases trap heat in the atmosphere

Acid rain - precipitation that is acidic due to atmospheric pollution

Ozone depletion - the thinning of the ozone layer in the stratosphere

Smog - a mixture of smoke and fog

Global dimming - the reduction in the amount of sunlight reaching the Earth's surface

Bioremediation - the use of living organisms to clean up pollution

Phytoremediation - the use of plants to clean up pollution

Mycoremediation - the use of fungi to clean up pollution

Biodegradation - the breakdown of organic materials by microorganisms

Composting - the process of decomposing organic waste into soil

Recycling - the process of converting waste into reusable materials

Waste management - the collection, transport, and disposal of waste

Environmental impact - the effect of human activities on the environment

Sustainable development - development that meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs

CELLS

Cells are the basic units of structure and function of the human body

Prokaryotic cells - cells without a nucleus

Eukaryotic cells - cells with a nucleus

Animal cells - cells without cell walls

Plant cells - cells with cell walls

Fungal cells - cells with cell walls and nuclei

Bacterial cells - cells without nuclei

Viral cells - cells without cellular structure

Prion - a protein that can cause disease

Cell membrane - the boundary between the cell and its environment

Cell wall - the rigid outer layer of a cell

Centrioles - organelles that help with cell division

Mitochondria - organelles that produce energy

Ribosomes - organelles that synthesize proteins

Endoplasmic reticulum - organelles that store and transport materials

Golgi apparatus - organelle that processes and packages materials

Lysosomes - organelles that break down waste

Vacuoles - organelles that store fluids

Chloroplasts - organelles that perform photosynthesis

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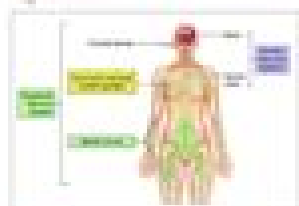
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RESPIRATORY SYSTEM

Functions

- 1. Ventilation - moving air in and out of the lungs
- 2. External respiration - exchanging oxygen and carbon dioxide between the lungs and the blood
- 3. Internal respiration - exchanging oxygen and carbon dioxide between the blood and the cells
- 4. Gas transport - moving oxygen and carbon dioxide through the blood
- 5. pH regulation - maintaining the balance of acids and bases in the blood



Structure

- 1. Trachea - windpipe
- 2. Bronchi - main airways
- 3. Bronchioles - smaller airways
- 4. Alveoli - air sacs where gas exchange occurs
- 5. Diaphragm - muscle that contracts and relaxes to move air in and out of the lungs

Regulation

- 1. Chemoreceptors - detect changes in blood gas levels
- 2. Baroreceptors - detect changes in blood pressure
- 3. Osmoreceptors - detect changes in blood osmolarity

RESPIRATORY SYSTEM

The respiratory system is responsible for the exchange of gases between the lungs and the blood



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- 5. Diaphragm - muscle that contracts and relaxes to move air in and out of the lungs
- 6. Pleural cavity - space between the lungs and the chest wall
- 7. Pleural fluid - lubricates the lungs and the chest wall
- 8. Surfactant - substance that reduces surface tension in the alveoli
- 9. Capillaries - small blood vessels where gas exchange occurs
- 10. Vessels - larger blood vessels that transport blood
- 11. Arteries - carry oxygenated blood away from the heart
- 12. Veins - carry deoxygenated blood back to the heart
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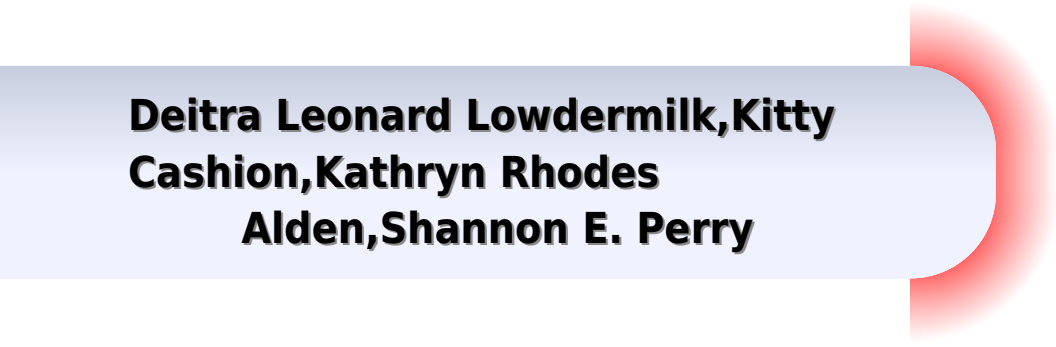
